- Guides picked up from the reception before 9am and returned to the same reception within 5 hours will be considered as ½ day activity. Guides picked up from reception after 9am will be charged for a full day, unless the guide is returned before 12 midday. Guides picked up after midday will be charged ½ day. Guides picked up at the reception and travelling with guests through the park, exiting from the north, will be charged for a full day, regardless of the time taken. If you wish to exit from the north with a guide, please drop the guide off at Kayonza, they will then catch public transport back to the park (transport fees will be covered by the park for park guides). If you cannot drop the guide at Kayonza, please cover their transport fee from the north gate to Kayonza, this does not exceed 5,000 RWF. If a guide is requested to accompany a visitor to Karengé Bush Camp overnight, an additional fee of 20,000 RWF is applied for the guides accommodation and food at Karengé.
- The Entry fee *inclusive* of a self-drive game viewing is payable by all day visitors, or *per night* for overnight visitors staying inside the park. E.g. for 1 night in the park (and the 2 days either side) the fee is payable once, for 2 nights it is payable twice. Entry fees are capped at 3 nights, so visitors staying longer than 3 nights will only be required to pay the entry fee for 3 nights up to a maximum of one week. Visitors staying outside the park are considered ‘day visitors’ and will be required to pay the entry fee for each day they enter the park.
- Children 5 and under are free of charge, no entry fee or activities fees apply. Activity fees rates for children are applicable for 6 – 12 year olds. 13 year olds and above pay adult rates for entry fees and activities.
- Residency status must be verified with documentation, or international visitor fees may be charged.
- Groups of Rwandan Nationals of more than 20 people automatically receive a group discount of 1,500 Rwf and will be charged at 5,000 Rwf per person.
- Game drives operated by AMC include the vehicle, driver and a guide. Pick-up and drop-off locations are within the south of the park only. Half day drives are from 6.30am – 11.30am in the morning and 12 – 5pm in the afternoon. Full day drives are from 6.30am – 5pm.
- Night drives begin at 5.30pm and end around 8 – 8.30pm. You will be picked up and dropped off at your accommodation facility. Only available in the south of the park.
- Boat trips are scheduled at the following times:
 - 7:30 – 8:30 am
 - 9:00 – 10:00 am
 - 3:00 – 4:00 pm
 - 4:30 – 6:00 pm (sunset trip)

Private boat trips can be organised and are charged at a flat rate for the boat, not per person. These should be booked at non-scheduled times starting between 10.30am – 1.30pm.

- Annual Passes are available and allow unlimited access to Akagera for a one-off payment for a period of 1 year. Single, Couple and Family passes are offered. The annual pass fee includes entry permits, but does not include vehicle fee or park activities, however, a 10% discount on park activities is offered to Annual Pass holders. Terms and conditions apply – please read them carefully.
- Tent hire does not include any bedding or camping equipment.
- Cash is accepted in USD, RWF, Euro and GBP. Current exchange rates will be listed at the reception. USD notes issued prior to 2005 cannot be accepted.

Activity Bookings, Cancellation & Refund Policy

To make a booking for activities you can call the park reception on +250 (0) 786 182 871 or email the tourism office akagera@africanparks.org.

You will need to provide the following details;

- Your name
- Contact phone number
- Activity type, date and time (for boat trips)
- Number of people (if there are children in the group, please also provide their age)
- Whether you want to be invoice in Rwf or USD (visa payments are processed in USD)

Park entry fees can be paid on arrival, however, if you would like to also be invoiced for your park entry fees so that there are no payments to make on arrival, please also provide the following details;

- Residency status of all visitors (international, resident or national)
- If there are children in the group, please provide their ages
- Number of vehicles* and country of registration
- Number of days, or nights if staying overnight, within the park

You will be sent an invoice with the amount to pay and details on how to make the payment. This can be done by bank transfer, credit card (Visa or MasterCard) or MoMo.

The minimum 50% deposit payment should be made to confirm the booking. Once payment has been made your booking is confirmed. Without a payment the booking is not confirmed. The reception will have a copy of your proof of payment on arrival and issue you with a receipt. Please inform the receptionist if you need a TIN number for tax purposes on your receipt.

How to make a payment

Payment for activity bookings can be made in three ways;

- 1) An invoice with AMC account details can be issued for a deposit into our Bank of Kigali account or for a bank transfer. AMC have both USD and RWF accounts and can receive local or international payments. Please note that all bank charges are for your own account.
- 2) You may phone the park reception who can process your payment by Visa or MasterCard card over the phone, or email the details to akagera@africanparks.org. No other credit or debit cards are accepted.
- 3) By MTN Mobile Money (MoMo). **Dial *182*8*1*222444* Amount* MOMO PIN#**. You can email or forward us the SMS from MTN Mobile Money as a proof of payment.

Cancellation policy

Cancellations are required to be in writing and incur the following charges:

- More than 30 days prior to arrival: 20% of the total amount due
- More than 7 days prior to arrival: 30% of the total amount due
- Less than 7 days prior to arrival: 50% of the total amount due
- After the activity was due to have commenced: 100% of the total amount due

If the cancellation is made by the park management due to bad weather conditions or otherwise, a full refund will be given. No refunds will be given for no-shows or late arrivals. An alternative time to do the activity may be offered at the discretion of Management.
